MiFID II Regulatory Update - Ex-Post Disclosure Requirements

BNY Mellon is required to comply with MiFID II¹ for in-scope products and services offered to clients. This includes the requirement for in-scope entities to disclose costs and charges associated with these products and services to impacted clients on at least an annual basis. Clients impacted by this requirement will receive their annual disclosure via an Ex-Post Disclosure Statement (EPDS) or will be able to review their cost and charge detail via existing invoices and/or reports.

The table below outlines the method in which in-scope entities will meet the EPDS disclosure requirements for each product offering². There are no MiFID II disclosure requirements for clients contracted to a non-MiFID II legal entity or utilising non-MiFID products and services. Further, there are no disclosure requirements for clients who utilise products and services that have no relevant costs and/or charges associated for that year.
